






#### WRITER'S STATEMENT

The son of a Holocaust survivor and a Ritchie Boy, I knew very little of his past, but his decision to record a SHOAH Foundation video revealed anecdotal material about his early years growing up in Vienna. It was not until after he passed away that I learned who the Ritchie Boys were and their significance. When the 60 Minutes broadcast segment about the Ritchie Boys was broadcast in May 2021, I set out to write the screenplay that pays tribute to their contributions to the war effort.

At a time where antisemitic hate crimes in the U.S. are on the rise, the historical significance of the Holocaust is more important than ever. The Ritchie Boys are a microcosm of the value immigrants bring who seek a new life in America free from tyranny and oppression.










A potential diplomat who is adept in social situations, his charm and good graces make him a natural leader although he needs to learn how to share power on the battlefield.
